



BSCR EXEMPTION FORM FOR GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES



Pursuant to Rule 6-12.4(c) (1), amended on May 12, 2005, the following exemption(s) are available for full time government employees.

An exemption from rule 6-12.3(a) (1) shall be granted if a member who had benefitted from the deferment of the Practicing with Professionalism requirement as of its May 12, 2005, elimination has already or thereafter been continuously engaged in the practice of law for a Florida or federal government entity as a full-time governmental employee for a period of at least 6 years. An exemption from rule 6-12.3(a) (2) shall be granted if a member has been continuously engaged in the practice of law for a Florida or federal governmental entity as a full-time governmental employee for a period of at least 6 years.

I have been continuously engaged in the practice of law for a Florida or federal governmental entity as a full-time governmental employee for a period of at least 6 years and benefitted from the deferment of Practicing with Professionalism.
(Note: If you do not meet this requirement for exempting Practicing with Professionalism, you are required to attend the seminar.)

I have been continuously engaged in the practice of law for a Florida or federal government entity as a full-time governmental employee for a period of at least 6 years and benefitted from the deferment of the YLD courses.
(Note: If you do not meet this requirement for exempting the YLD courses, you may be eligible to defer.)
